The Perl Foundation (TPF) is a mentoring organisation for the GCI. We are now seeking applications from students, and mentors, wishing to participate under the guidance of the TPF for this year (2011).

Google Code-in is a contest for pre-university students (e.g., high school and secondary school students ages 13-17) with the goal of encouraging young people to participate in open source.

For many students the Google Code-in contest is their first introduction to open source development. For Google Code-in we work with open source organizations, each of whom has experience mentoring students in the Google Summer of Code program, to provide "bite sized" tasks for participating students to complete.
